

SFP IN KIRKKONUMMI MUNICIPAL ELECTION PROGRAM



The Swedish People's Party is your voice for a Kirkkonummi that puts people at the center. It is important that all residents feel safe and enjoy living in our municipality. We work at all levels for a Kirkkonummi with two strong national languages, Swedish and Finnish. Bilingual services should function effectively at all levels.

Our students have the right to receive their education in healthy school buildings, which is why it is essential that the construction of the new buildings starts as planned.

Equality is a fundamental value in everything we do. For SFP, it is important that there is an equal representation of women and men in leadership positions in the municipality.

We want to invest in preventive and health-promoting activities. Investments in exercise, sports, and culture create well-being and make our municipality vibrant and attractive. Hobbies are an essential part of well-being. We believe that all young people have the right to meaningful and free leisure activities. We want children to have access to hobby activities in connection with the school day.

Every resident should have the right to well-functioning healthcare services. The elderly population should be offered tailored services based on their individual needs. Functional assisted living options should be available when needed.

We want to see pleasant residential environments adapted to residents' different life situations and a broader selection of single-family home plots. Planning and construction should promote sustainability, both in terms of building materials and energy use. In planning, we safeguard private ownership of forests and land. Kirkkonummi has a unique

and diverse natural environment that we want to protect.

There needs to be efficient recycling, reuse, and waste management with enough diverse collection points. We see Kirkkonummi playing a central role in promoting energy-smart solutions and sustainable procurement. SFP is working for Kirkkonummi to become climate-neutral by 2035.

We need both strong growth centers and a vibrant rural area. SFP wants to ensure the vitality of the entire municipality, where growth centers can thrive side by side. Regarding municipal and property taxes, we support a restrained tax policy.

SFP advocates for sensible traffic planning with good connections to, from, and between the municipality's four growth centers. We are working for better and smoother public transport, improved train connections, and more long-distance train stops in Kirkkonummi. Our goal is also to establish more new pedestrian and bicycle paths within the municipality.

We want to see strong cooperation between the municipality and businesses to create the best conditions for investments and entrepreneurship.
